

Argumentation-Chain

Headline - attract attention and interest like in a newspaper article.

Present-Situation / Facts / Background Information

Give your listeners the chance to identify themselves by outlining the situation.

"The facts are ..." "Today we are looking at ..." "The current situation shows ..."

> Risk - Itemize the logical risk of inactivity. "If we do not react ..."

Challenge / Vision / Issue - State what has to be addressed. Show what can be achieved before offering a solution. "Therefore we have to focus on ..."

Answer / Proposal / Solution

What you believe should be done. Detail how you will achieve what you propose.

"The best way of dealing with this is ..."

Benefits - Outline the benefits of your proposal. (reverse the risk) "By doing this we will gain ..."

Headline - Close your presentation by enforcing your message!
