Smart Villages solutions

- Agriculture: short food supply chains connecting consumers and producers, precision farming, satellite sensing, automatisation (advanced sensors, smart resource management, robots, drones)...
- Mobility: ride sharing, vehicle sharing, ride services for elderly, electric vehicles (personal, bikes), e-bike networks...
- **Economy**: SMS in rural areas, bio based economy, digital platforms for local producers and companies, shared economy,...
- Energy: decentralized energy, energy cooperatives, smart grids, home batteries, renewable energy sources...
- **Tourism**: digital platforms for reservations, tourist cards, distributed hotels...
- **Social aspects**: new job opportunities, long term care solutions, elearning...
- **Health**: telemedicine, body sensors...
- Environment: reducing resources usage, reducing emissions...






















EU supports rural development

Towards stronger, connected, resilient and prosperous rural areas by 2040.
























Rural pact

The Rural Pact will provide a common framework for the engagement and cooperation of a wide range of actors at the EU, national, regional and local level.
























EU Rural Action Plan






