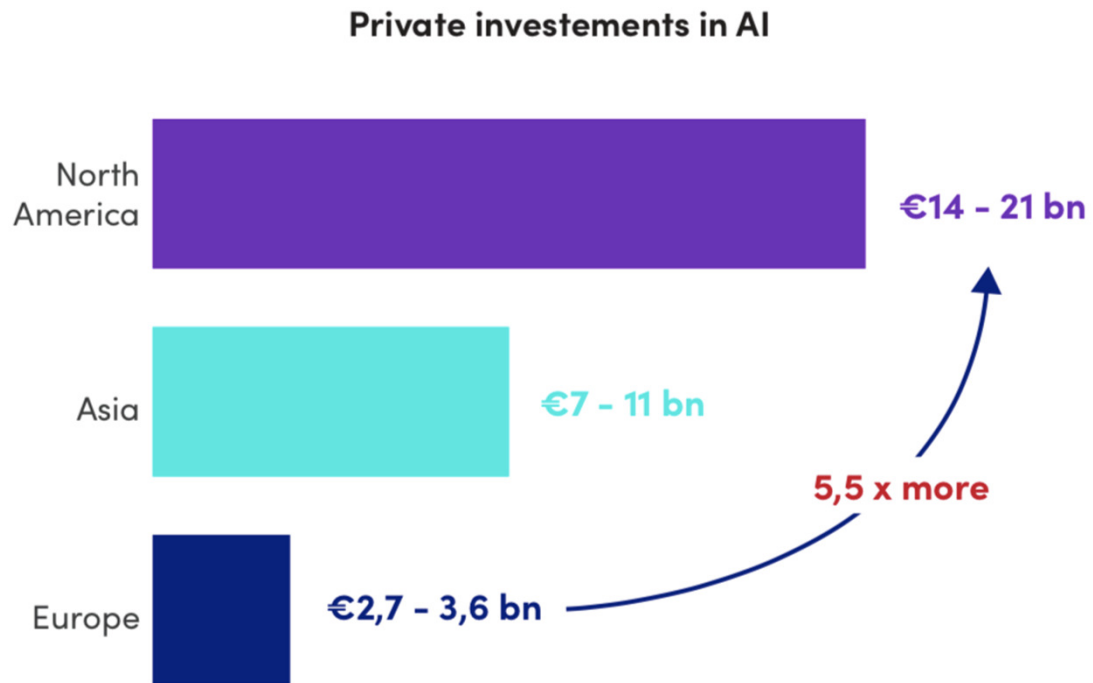

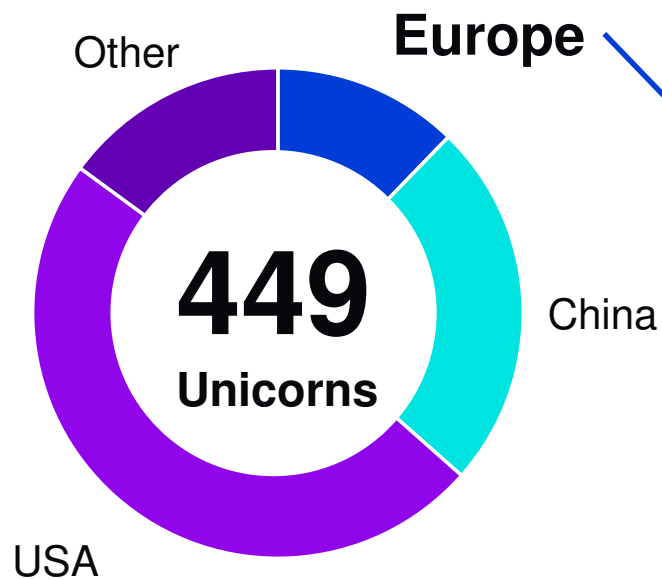

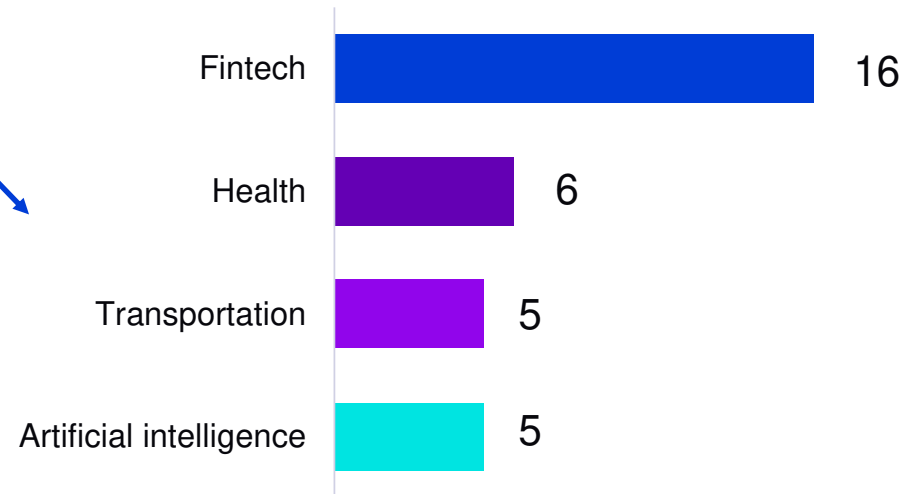

European companies fail to grow

Only 12% of Unicorns (billion \$ startups) are European - 5% without the UK



►► By 2025, Europe should have **100 Unicorns** and at least **15 of them should be in Artificial Intelligence**

So how do we catch up?

€750 bn

to be spent between 2021-23

- Twin focus on **digital & green** recovery
- **3/4** of it will be spent by national government
- National Governments are submitting their spending plans **right now**
- **Slovenia** has committed to **20%** on digital of the **€10.5 bn** it will receive.

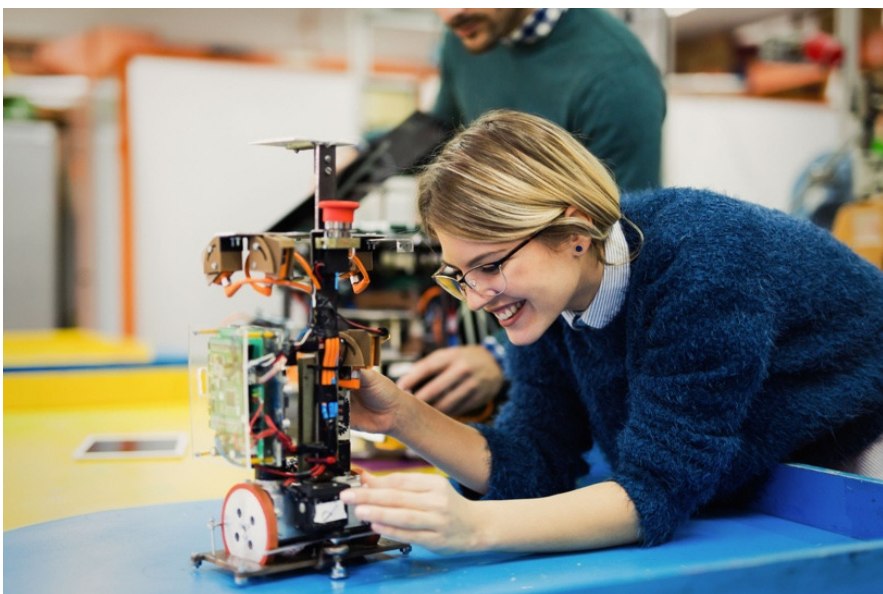

How to get there: digital skills



Bring schools to the digital age

- **Retrain school teachers** – only 40% feel ready to use digital technologies
- **Invest in digital education tools & connectivity** – COVID exposed huge gaps
- **Modernise school curricula** – basic programming should be taught to all



Use AI to predict jobs of the future


- **Good policymaking requires solid evidence**
- **AI-powered forecasting** can look at potential job disruption & future job markets
- **Belgian project underway** – should be scaled at EU level
