In view of the increasing relevance of the Asset Management system based on the ISO 55000 family of international standards, the Slovenian Chamber of Commerce and Industry is organising an event in September to exchange domestic and foreign experience in this area. Modern technologies, including digitisation, are systematically applied. The asset management system is beneficial for a wide range of private and public organizations and is also being promoted abroad by some government bodies and local authorities. In Slovenia, the field is still in a relatively early phase, so this event will add one more piece to the mosaic of introducing it to the wider business community.

You are therefore invited to a conference dedicated to identifying opportunities to improve value creation through effective asset management at all stages of the asset lifecycle. We will address current concepts with world-renowned international experts and present domestic experiences closely linked to sustainability and digital transformation.

The conference will be an excellent opportunity to learn about a management system that, if implemented and used consistently, can lead to significant savings, increased reliability, efficiency and effectiveness of relevant processes, and increased value creation from assets.
