Reporting time: 14.00 h





HORGOŠ:

- Entry to Serbia: waiting time 30 minutes, 500 m long waiting line
- Exit from Serbia: waiting time 1-2 hours, 1 km long waiting line

KELEBIA

- Entry to Serbia: waiting time 1 hour, 200 m long waiting line
- Exit from Serbia: waiting time 2 hours, 1 km long waiting line

TOVARNIK-ŠID

- Entry to Serbia : no delays
- Exit from Serbia : no delays
- On Tovarnik-Šid border crossing, the goods coming from Croatia can enter only if export customs clearance was done in Croatia. The goods going to Croatia for unloading should undergo customs clearance in Croatia.

BATROVCI

- Entry to Serbia: waiting time 6-7 hours, the line length depends on the number of the incoming trucks (4-6 km)
- Exit from Serbia: waiting time 8-10 hours, 5-6 km long waiting line

PREŠEVO BORDER CROSSING

- Entry to Serbia: waiting time 30 minutes, 2 trucks in the waiting line
- Exit from Serbia: waiting time 30 minutes, 3 trucks in the waiting line

GRADINA

- Entry to Serbia: waiting time 20-30 minutes, 5 trucks in the waiting line.
- Exit from Serbia: waiting time 1-2 hours, 10-15 trucks in the waiting line

VATIN

- Entry to Serbia: waiting time 1-2 hours, 20 trucks in the waiting line
- Exit from Serbia: waiting time 2-3 hours, over 20 trucks in the waiting line.



ĐERDAP

- Entry to Serbia: no information.
- Exit from Serbia : no information.

SRPSKA CRNJA

- Entry to Serbia: no information.
- Exit from Serbia: no information.

Incoming trucks are arriving in convoys, so the number of trucks in the waiting line is varying throughout the day. Sometimes it goes up to 40-60 trucks.

- Macelj border crossing: few-hour wait on entry to Croatia, no delays on exit.
- Bregana border crossing: few-hour wait on entry to Croatia; one-hour wait on exit.
- Bajakovo border crossing: few-hour wait on both entry and exit.
- Transit through Croatia is conducted in convoys, and there are jams on border crossings when convoys arrive.

Due to the snowfall in Gorski Kotar and storm in the coastal area, there is still no free passage towards and from Rijeka for trucks with trailers and tractors with semi-trailers.

Only for passenger vehicles are open: A1 highway Zagreb-Split-Ploče between the interchanges Sveti Rok and Posedarje (other categories are taking the bypass on the state roads accross Gračac-Obrovac-Karin or Gračac-Karin).



HERZEGOVINA

BOSNIA AND 0 0

Gradiška:

- On BIH exit, there is a 10 km long waiting line and some vehicles have been waiting for more than 24 hours.
- On BIH entry, waiting time is 5 hours.
- Customs office Gradiška and inspection services are working as usual.
- After having customs procedures finished, the drivers continue their way inland without having to form convoys.

Rača:

- On BIH entry, there are 40-50 trucks in the waiting line, waiting time is around 5
- On BIH exit, waiting time is 1 hour, there are 10 trucks in the waiting line.
- Still without escort for transit

SLOVENIA

SLO-CRO border crossing:

- Gruškovje: waiting time on exit is 2 hours.
- Obrežje: waiting time on exit is 2.5 hours.
- Središče ob Dravi: waiting time on exit is 1-2 hours.
- Zavrč: waiting time on exit is 30 minutes.
- Dobovec: waiting time on exit is 1.5 hour.
- Due to the storm, the road between Nanos and Ajdovščina is closed for refrigerator trucks and tarp trucks.
- Regional road Ajdovščina-Selo-Ajdovščina has closed down the traffic for vehicles up to 8
- Regional road Col-Črni vrh-Godovič is closed for HGVs due to the snow. And in Croatia, through border crossing Petrina and Babno Polje.
- At Obrežje border crossing, there is a 3 km long waiting line on the highway, and 1 km long line at border crossing Gruškovje.

ITA-SLO border crossing:

Situation unchanged, convoys are being organised from Italy through Slovenia.

SLO-HUN border crossing :

Situation unchanged, convoys are being organised (through Pince).

SLO-AUT border crossing:

Transit truck flow is normal, but on entry, they need to have full fuel tanks and must not stop anywhere in Austria. The trucks without full tanks are not given passage.



Due to COVID-19 state of emergency, the Ministry of Interior Affairs has issued a new measure that allows HGV movement through Slovenia during weekends for vehicles with gross weight over 7.7 tons. As for Sundays from 8am till 9 pm, that referrs also to holidays. In the pre-Easter period, Fridays from 2pm till 9pm.

The European Commission has presented practical guidelines to ensure the continuous flow of goods across EU via »green lanes«

The aim is to keep freight moving across the EU during the current pandemic.

To ensure that EU-wide supply chains continue to operate, Member States are requested to designate all the border-crossing points on the trans-European transport network (TEN-T) as 'green lane' border crossings. The green lane border crossings should be open to all freight vehicles, whatever goods they are carrying.

Crossing the border, including any checks and health screening, should not take more than 15 minutes.

The Commission recommends that Member States take action to ensure the free movement of all workers involved in international transport, whatever the transport mode.

In particular, rules such as travel restrictions, and mandatory quarantine of transport workers not displaying symptoms, should be waived.

Member States should not require that transport workers carry a doctor's certificate to prove their good health.

The Slovenian police force is preparing how to introduce this into its border management.

MONTENEGRO

Dobrakovo (MNE) - Gostun (SRB) border crossing :

- There is a 4 km long waiting line on entry with 3 hours of waiting time, and a 500 m long waiting line on exit with 30 min of waiting time.
- TCG is dispatched regularly, upon arrival to the border crossing, the trucks are dispatched immediately.
- There is no quarantine, Bosnian and foreign drivers are given written instructions to regularly contact epidemiologists

Ilino brdo – Klobuk border crossing from Bosnia :

- There is 1 truck on entry, waiting time is 10 minutes. No delays on exit.
- During the 08.00-12.00 working hours, waiting time is 1.5 hour. After that period, waiting time is 30 minutes. Customs procedures are performed as HGVs arrive on border crossing.
- No quarantine.





- No delays on both entry and exit.
- There is no separate line for vehicles in transit and they are in the waiting line with the rest of the trucks. However, transit vehicles are given written instructions on deadline to exit Montenegro.

Božaj (MNE) - Hani i Hotit (AL) Border crossing:

- There are 10 trucks in the waiting line. Waiting time is 30 min until all customs officers do the transit, and then with the police escort they go to the Customs Terminal. In Podgorica Waiting time on exit is 15 minutes.
- There is no separate line for vehicles in transit and they are in the waiting line with the rest of the trucks. However, transit vehicles are given written instructions on deadline to exit Montenegro.
- No quarantine.

ALBANIA

- H. Hotit (MNE): waiting time on entry is 1,5 hours, waiting time on exit is 2 hours.
- Durres (ITA): waiting time on entry is 3 hours waiting time on exit is 24 hours.
- Morine (XK): waiting time on entry is 45 minutes, waiting time on exit is 2 hours.
- Q.Thane (MKD): waiting time on entry is 2,5 hours, waiting time on exit is 30 hours.
- Kapshtice: waiting time on entry is 30 minutes, waiting time on exit is 25 minutes.
- Kakavia: waiting time on entry is 45 minutes, waiting time on exit is 30 minutes.
- No convoys, individual entries with government authorizations (max 15 min. with permit obtained through vehicle application on the Traffic Police email address)
- Quarantine applies only to Albanian drivers (for the time being, the ones coming from Italy, Austria and Greece), no delays for foreigners.

As decided by the Customs, import and export customs clearance can be done more easily on border crossings from 12.00h

Albania has introduced new restrictions on movement. Weekends, i.e. Saturday 00.00-13.00h, and then complete restriction on movement up to Monday 5am (only police, military and the media representatives will be on the streets)

From Monday to Friday, movement is allowed from 05.00 – 13.00h.

Customs officers at border crossings are working, the interior customs offices are closed.







AT - DE (source: https://www.asfinaq.at/verkehr/reisezeiten/):

- Kiefersfelden no delays in both directions.
- Pocking/Suben on AT entry, waiting time is 30 minutes.
- Bad Reichenhall/Walserberg on AT entry, waiting time is 30 minutes.

DE - PL

- A4 bei Görlitz no delays.
- Olszyna on highway A15 from the Cottbus direction no delays from Germany to Poland.
- A12 from Germany towards Polish Slubnice currently no delays.
- A11 from Germany towards Polish Kolbaskowo no delays.

DE - CZ

Waidhaus/Rozvadov – no delays.

FR - DE

- From France to Germany, from Roppenheima and D4 freeway towards A5 access, there are no delavs.
- Lauterburg from FR to A9 towards Germany no delays.
- L98 from France to Offenburg no delays.
- Highway 28 on crossing Kehl no delays.
- Entry from France from highway A36 to A5 in Gemany no delays.

DE - CH

- Rheinfelden: from CH towards DE, waiting time is up to 30 minutes, 2 hours in the opposite direction.
- Koblenz: on CH entry, waiting time is around 3 hours. It is 10 min in the opposite direction.
- Thayngen: one-hour wait in both direction.
- Weil am Rhein: from CH towards DE, waiting time is 45 minutes. It is up to 2 hours in the opposite direction.
- Police are still controlling all traffic participants. In case anyone has high temperature on entering Germany, they are placed in the closest quarantine.
