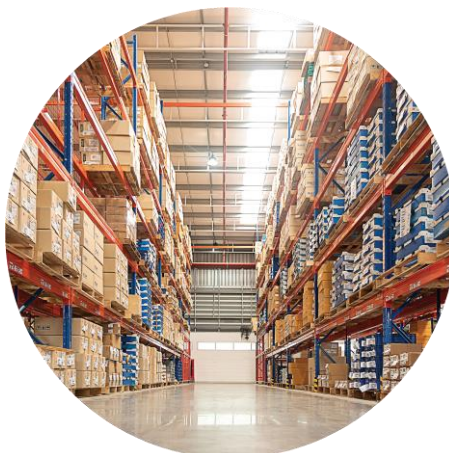


# DAILY REPORT

31.03.2020.



**Reporting time: 14.00 h**

## SERBIA



### **HORGOŠ:**

- *Entry to Serbia: waiting time 1 hour, 100 m long waiting line.*
- *Exit from Serbia: waiting time 2-3 hours, 2 km long waiting line, depends on the incoming convoys.*

### **KELEBIA**

- *Entry to Serbia: waiting time 10 minutes, 2 trucks in the waiting line.*
- *Exit from Serbia: no waiting time 1-2 hours, over 1 km long waiting line.*

### **TOVARNIK-ŠID**

- *Entry to Serbia: no delays.*
- *Exit from Serbia: waiting time 10 minutes (2 trucks).*
- *On Tovarnik-Šid border crossing, the goods coming from Croatia can enter only if export customs clearance was done in Croatia. The goods going to Croatia for unloading should undergo customs clearance in Croatia.*

### **BATROVCI**

- *Entry to Serbia: waiting time 1 hour, 20-30 trucks in the waiting line, a convoy is expected to arrive.*
- *Exit from Serbia: waiting time 30 minutes, 4 trucks in the waiting line.*

### **PREŠEVO BORDER CROSSING**

- *Entry to Serbia: waiting time 1-2 hours, around 10-20 trucks in the waiting line.*
- *Exit from Serbia: waiting time 2-3 hours, 1 km long waiting line.*

### **GRADINA**

- *Entry to Serbia: waiting time 1-2 hour, 10-20 trucks in the waiting line.*
- *Exit from Serbia: waiting time 1 hour, 20-25 trucks in the waiting line.*

### **VATIN**

- *Entry to Serbia: no delays.*
- *Exit from Serbia: waiting time 1-2 hours, 7 trucks. Currently, the Romanians are not letting anyone pass, the borderzone is full.*



## **ĐERDAP**

- *Entry to Serbia: no information.*
- *Exit from Serbia: no information.*

## **SRPSKA CRNJA**

- *Entry to Serbia: no information.*
- *Exit from Serbia: no information.*

*Incoming trucks are arriving in convoys, so the number of trucks in the waiting line is varying throughout the day. Sometimes it goes up to 20-40 trucks.*

# **BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA**



### **Gradiška:**

- *On BiH exit, waiting time is up to 1 hour, 20 trucks in the waiting line.*
- *On BiH entry, waiting time is 1 hour, 20 trucks in the waiting line.*
- *Unlike the previous days, there is a big crowd at the customs terminal Gradiška.*
- *After having customs procedures finished, the drivers continue their way inland without having to form convoys.*

### **Rača:**

- *On BiH entry, there is a long waiting line, waiting time is 5 hours to enter the terminal.*
- *No delays on BiH exit, 5 trucks in the waiting line.*
- *The customs office and inspection services are working at a slower pace because they have divided the same number of people into 4 shifts so that the office could be open 24 h.*
- *Still without escort for transit.*

*On March 24<sup>th</sup> 2020, the BiH Council of Ministers decided that transit traffic between BiH and the Republic of Serbia should take place only through the border crossing Rača in BiH, that is, Sremska Rača in Serbia.*

*The Customs Administration has informed all customs offices that the goods transiting through the territory of BiH to other countries are sent exclusively to the Sremska Rača crossing, in order to avoid unnecessary return of carriers from other crossings.*

## CROATIA

- **Macelj border crossing: no delays.**
- **Bregana border crossing: 30 min waiting time on entry**
- **Bajakovo border crossing: no delays**
- **Stara Gradiška border crossing: no delays.**
- **Transit through Croatia is conducted in convoys, and there are jams on border crossings when convoys arrive.**

**Due to the windstorm, speed limit is now 40 km/h on A1 highway Zagreb-Split-Ploče between the interchanges Sveti Rok and Posedarje..**

## SLOVENIA

### **SLO-CRO border crossing :**

- **Gruškovje: no delays..**
- **Obrežje: waiting time 30 min on exit.**
- **Dobovec: no delays.**

### **ITA-SLO border crossing:**

- **Situation unchanged, convoys are being organised from Italy through Slovenia.**
- **When a driver enters Italy, he must complete a declaration allowing him to stay in Italy for 72 hours. An example of the statement; <https://www.gzs.si/Portals/Panoga-Zdruzenje-Promet/koronavirus/italija/26%20MAR%20MODELLO%20DICHIARAZIONE%20CONDUCENTI.pdf>.**

### **SLO-HUN border crossing :**

- **Situation unchanged, convoys are being organised (through Pince).**

### **SLO-AUT border crossing :**

- **The truck flow is normal, but on entry, they need to have full fuel tanks and must not stop anywhere in Austria. The trucks without full tanks are not given passage.**

**On Vipavski freeway, between Nanos and Ajdovščina, the traffic is closed for refrigerator trucks and tarp trucks up to 8 tons. This is a first-degree restriction.**

**On A2 highway Ljubljana-Obrežje, between Brežice access and Obrežje Terminal in the Obrežje direction, there is a big number of trucks and a waiting line in the emergency stopping lane.**



## RUSSIA

### *Border crossing situation report:*

- **Senkovka/Novi Yurkovich:** no delays on entry and exit.
- **Grejac / Pogar:** no delays on entry and exit.
- **Bacevsk / Trobortnoe:** no delays on entry and exit.
- **Terehovo:** no delays on entry and exit.
- **Patemieki:** waiting time is around 2 hours on both entry and exit.
- **Silene:** no delays on entry and exit.
- **Grebnevo:** no delays on entry and exit.
- **Terespol – Brest:** not in use.
- **Domanovo – Makrany:** no delays on entry and exit.



## MONTENEGRO

### **Dobrakovo (MNE) – Gostun (SRB) border crossing:**

- There are 15 trucks in the waiting line on entry with 1 hour of waiting time, 15 min waiting on exit.
- TCG is dispatched regularly, upon arrival to the border crossing, the trucks are dispatched immediately.
- There is no quarantine, Bosnian and foreign drivers are given written instructions to regularly contact epidemiologists.

### **Ilino brdo – Klobuk border crossing from Bosnia:**

- No delays on entry and exit.
- During the 08.00-12.00 working hours, waiting time is 1.5 hour. After that period, waiting time is 30 minutes. Customs procedures are performed as HGVs arrive on border crossing.
- No quarantine.





### **Debeli Brijeg (MNE) – Karasović (HR) border crossing:**

- *Waiting time is 15 minutes on entry, no delays on exit.*
- *There is no separate line for vehicles in transit and they are in the waiting line with the rest of the trucks. However, transit vehicles are given written instructions on deadline to exit Montenegro.*
- *No quarantine.*

### **Božaj (MNE) – Hani i Hotit (AL) Border crossing:**

- *There are 20 trucks in the waiting line on entry, waiting time is 3 hours, no delays on exit.*
- *There is no separate line for vehicles in transit and they are in the waiting line with the rest of the trucks. However, transit vehicles are given written instructions on deadline to exit Montenegro.*
- *No quarantine.*



- *H. Hotit (MNE): there are 8 trucks in the waiting line on entry, waiting time on exit is 20 minutes.*
- *Durres (ITA): waiting time on entry is 3 hours (15 vehicles), waiting time on exit is 24 hours.*
- *Morine (XK): waiting time on entry is 1 hour (5 vehicles), waiting time on exit is 2.5 hours.*
- *Q.Thane (MKD): waiting time on entry is 45 minutes, waiting time on exit is 30 minutes.*
- *Kapshtice: waiting time on entry is 30 minutes, waiting time on exit is 25 minutes.*
- *Kakavia: waiting time on entry is 45 minutes, waiting time on exit is 30 minutes.*
- *Waiting time is sometimes longer where there are import-export customs clearance operations.*
- *No convoys, individual entries with government authorizations (max 15 min. with permit – obtained through vehicle application on the Traffic Police email address)*
- *Quarantine applies only to Albanian drivers (for the time being, the ones coming from Italy, Austria and Greece), no delays for foreigners.*

*As decided by the Customs, import and export customs clearance can be done more easily on border crossings from 12.00h*

*Albania has introduced new restrictions on movement. Weekends, i.e. Saturday 00.00-13.00h, and then complete restriction on movement up to Monday 5am (only police, military and the media representatives will be on the streets)*

*From Monday to Friday, movement is allowed from 05.00 – 13.00h.*

*Customs officers at border crossings are working, the interior customs offices are closed.*

# GERMANY



## **AT – DE** (source <https://www.asfinag.at/verkehr/reisezeiten/>):

- Kiefersfelden – no delays.
- Pocking/Suben – there is a 4 km long waiting line from AT towards DE, waiting time is around 1 hour. Waiting time is 10 min in the opposite direction.
- Bad Reichenhall/Walserberg – no delays.

## **DE – PL** (different sources)

- A4 bei Görlitz – no delays .
- Olszyna on highway A15 from the Cottbus direction – no delays from Germany to Poland.
- A12 from Germany towards Polish Slubnice– no delays.
- A11 from Germany towards Polish Kolbaskowo– no delays. . Waiting time is 30 min in the opposite direction.

## **DE – CZ**

- Waidhaus/Rozvadov – no delays.

## **FR – DE**

- From France to Germany, from Roppenheim and D4 freeway towards A5 access, waiting time is up to 30 min.
- Lauterburg from FR to A9 towards Germany– no delays.
- L98 from France to Offenburg – no delays.
- Highway 28 on crossing Kehl – no delays.
- Entry from France from highway A36 to A5 in Germany - no delays.

## **DE – CH**

- Rheinfelden: from DE towards CH, there is a 5 km long waiting line and waiting time is 1.5 hour. 45 min in the opposite direction.
- Koblenz: from DE towards CH, waiting time is 1 hour. 10 min in the opposite direction.
- Thayngen: from DE towards CH. waiting time is 2 hours. 10 min in the opposite direction
- Weil am Rhein: from DE towards CH, there is a 4 km long waiting line. In the opposite direction waiting time is 1.5 hour and there is a 5 km long waiting line..
- Police are still controlling all traffic participants. In case anyone has high temperature on entering Germany, they are placed in the closest quarantine.
