Customs offices:	ATA carnets are accepted at the port and airport where Customs facilities for the clearance of goods and passengers' baggage are provided. At the land frontier with Spain ATA carnets are accepted at all hours.

the port or airport. For traffic over the land boundary between Spain and Gibraltar ATA carnets are accepted 24 hours a day
