EMAS ORGANISATIONS IN AUSTRIA (1)

Currently there are 292 registered organisations with 1068 sites in Austria. In the EU ranking Austria is on position number 4 in absolute terms and on the second position regarding registrations in relation to million inhabitants.


 There are 9 environmental verifier organisations and 2 individual environmental verifiers operative in Austria.

EMAS ORGANISATIONS IN AUSTRIA (2)

 The proportion of small, medium and large organisations is very balanced in Austria.


Main Sectors:

- D35 Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply
- E38 Waste collection, treatment and disposal activities; materials recovery
- H52 Warehousing and support activities for transportation
- N81 Services to buildings and landscape activities
- P85 Education



EMAS REGISTRATIONS IN AUSTRIA (3)

- 292 EMAS organisations in Austria
- east-west decline
- more than half of all EMAS registrations are located in Lower Austria and in the region of Vienna, whereas Tyrol and Vorarlberg together have only 18 EMAS registrations
- need for information and promotion activities concerning EMAS mainly in the western provinces of Austria
- more EMAS registrations in West Austria within the next 4 years



LEGISLATION

- The national Environmental Management Act includes some regulatory reliefs for EMAS companies
 - Issuing of a consolidated approval notice consolidation of all the approvals valid for the facility in one single notice
 - limitations of official control obligations longer intervals

WORKSHOPS - EMAS FOR STAKEHOLDERS

 EMAS workshops for Stakeholders are organised twice a year to exchange experiences and to give special information. In 2017 there will be three workshops in the context of the European Intereg Project ENHANCE.



EMAS CONFERENCE AND NATIONAL EMAS AWARD

 A national EMAS conference, where also the national EMAS award is awarded, is organised and held once a year. The topic of the EMAS conference 2017 was "circular economy".
