

CHANGING A COUNTRY'S FUTURE, THROUGH THE SUCCESS OF GLOBAL STARTUPS



In order to innovate and create something new, you need to be in a place that boosts your creativity and that stimulates your imagination




...and the best way to promote that, is by bringing together talented people to work at the same place. And that is the key: bringing talent home.




So that's how Start-Up Chile was born. The Chilean Government, started attracting talented entrepreneurs from all over the world, with its main objective posed in positioning Chile as the leading innovation and entrepreneurial hub of Latin America.




We just want you and your team to come to Chile. We give you \$ 33K, a year working Visa and a Soft Landing\*....also, we provide mentorship and we give you a cool workplace where you have the chance to build your company surrounded by peers from all over the world, everyone working in their own game changer dreams... from Chile to the world! In return, Start-Up Chile doesn't ask for any equity. Just your commitment and contribution to the Chilean entrepreneurial ecosystem is needed. The way you pay back to Chile is by doing social impact activities that promote innovation among Chileans. And that's Start-Up Chile's equity.

<sup>\*</sup> Soft-Landing consists in: helping the entrepreneurs to get a Chilean ID card in 2 days, open a personal bank account in a week, get a cellphone, contacts of available properties to get an apartment where to live (only contacts), among others.

Sounds like a perfect deal, no? And that's not all of it!




After Start-Up Chile program, you have the chance to be part of Start-Up Chile SCALE. About 10 top companies from Start-Up Chile are selected (3 times a year) and receive up to 100K, again, equity free!!




Today, we can proudly say that Start-Up Chile has grown as the biggest and most diverse startup community, with more than 2700 entrepreneurs.


Our entrepreneurs have raised Millions of dollars (more than 110 million dollars in total). Some of our startups have been acquired by bigger corporations (12 startups, such as WeHostels, acquired by Student Universe, CruiseWise, acquired by TripAdvisor, Aventones, acquired by Bla Bla Car, among others), they all have created new Jobs (+1600)...and some really cool stuff has been made in here



Like Lab4U, a...great App that it's been awarded by Intel, that transforms any smartphone into a Science Lab...affecting, this way, thousands of students by making science into something that anyone can experiment




Or like Bureo Skateboards, from the USA...a skateboard company that makes their boards out of recycled fishing nets that has partnered with Patagonia and that is saving the planet!



Or like themidgame, from Colombia... a marketplace where advertisers have access to relevant information about influencers in every industry.



Or BabyBe, from Germany and Chile...a groundbreaking device that allows premature babies to be in contact with their mothers right after the birth



All of these Startups are affecting people's lives in different parts of the globe...they all are making a difference! and they all have been made from people with different backgrounds and parts of the World....but with a couple of things in common: GREAT TALENT...And they all have been made in Start-Up Chile.




and even more important, they all have succeed on adding their own seed to this new ecosystem that have sprung.


Start-Up Chile has 3 application processes in a year. If you apply in September, results will be announced in December, and you will be starting the program in February 2016. The founder (beneficiary) must be living in Chile for 7 months.

If you apply in January 2016, results will be announced in April 2016, and you will be starting the program in June 2016. Etc.

Selection criteria		
Criterion	Description	Weighting
Participants	Composition, qualification and experience of the beneficiary (15%) → Demonstrable achievements, Number of times founding a start-up, Background and make-up of the team  Beneficiary networks (15%) → Communities they participate, Contact networks, Impact they could achieve in the Entrepreneurship Ecosystem in Chile  Composition, qualification and experience of the executor(s) (10%) → Demonstrable achievements, Number of times founding a start-up, Background and make-up of the team  Executor(s) networks (10%) → Communities they participate, Contact networks, Impact they could achieve in the Entrepreneurship Ecosystem in Chile	50%
Value of Projec	Market and competitive position (25%) → Target segment, Market size, Product testing, Competitors  Product or service (25%) → Attractiveness to investors, Existing mentors, Global Impact, Importance of the problem the project aims to solve, Competitive Advantage	50%

This is what Start-Up Chile considers when evaluating the projects.

Each application is evaluated by 3-4 judges provided by Younoodle. (In general, one academic, investor, serial entrepreneur, or expert from the industry you are applying). Then, there is a Committee in Chile that makes the final decision, considering the information provided by Younoodle.
