Historical background



- Development started from the 19th century
- Main subsectors
 - Engineered lumber
 - Tie manufacturing for heavy railway construction
 - Barrel and match manufacturing
- Furniture manufacturing in the 19th century:
 - □ Steam bent furniture factories (Thonet)
 - □ Lingel cabinet
- 20th century: major loss of production, capacity, raw materials and markets due to Trianon Peace Treaty after WWI -> rebuilding
